# The Challenges:


- Covid-19 forced educational institutions into digital teaching, revealing overlooked challenges.

## Our project update and what to expect going forward:


During the first year of the project, the consortium focused mainly on **Work Package 2 (WP2) - Develop a Qualifications Framework for Pedagogical Digital Competencies based on DigCompEdu**, led by the University of Florence with the collaboration of the consortium.

With this work we were able to suggest improvements to the DigCompEdu framework by integrating three new elements in the "Professional engagement" dimension and adding a new section in the area of teachers' pedagogical competences, named "Socio-emotional and relational skills". You can know more about this process here.

In the next steps, the team working on Work Package 3 (WP3) - Development of a Curriculum for the Pedagogical Digital Competencies, lead by UCLL, will create a professionalization process for this newly developed DigCompEdu model. The intention is to focus on the new competencies. You can know more about the tasks here.
